

Introduction:

The ESPGHAN **Endoscopy or Laparoscopy** Video Clip Session is designed to enable colleagues to present interesting findings on gastrointestinal endoscopy/laparoscopy, showcase new endoscopic techniques, share innovations developed with existing endoscopic techniques, demonstrate management of complications during endoscopies or share endoscopic/laparoscopic findings in rare diseases or just to present something interesting what was recognized during endoscopy or laparoscopy procedure. Video clips should not exceed 2 minutes in length. In addition, background and conclusion slides should be added to explain what and why has been presented.

Those who would like to submit a Video Clip must accompany their video with **an abstract** in the usual format. For guidelines on how to submit an abstract, please see [abstract submission guidelines](#). Abstracts will be scored along with their accompanying video.

After submitting an abstract, please email associated video clip, with the abstract number to espghan_abstracts@kenes.com. The best of the accepted videos will be presented during a special session at this year's Annual Meeting. After the video presentation, authors will have a few minutes to answer the questions regarding the video case.

The deadline to submit your video and accompanying abstract is by the abstract submission deadline. If both files (video and abstract) have not been submitted, the submission will be considered incomplete and will not be reviewed. Following this date, no submissions will be reviewed.

Guidelines for Endoscopy/Laparoscopy Video Submission:

- **One video per abstract submission** is allowed.
- **Endoscopy Videos must be provided in MP4 format only.**
 - Before you submit your video, be sure it meets the following requirements:
 - Peer-reviewed Endoscopy Videos submissions will be evaluated based on educational content and audio/visual quality. Accepted videos will be presented



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in an Endoscopy Videos session.

- Videos cannot exceed **2 minutes** to be considered.
- Videos must be uploaded on this page during the submission process in **MP4** format following the ESPGHAN 2026 upload guidelines.
- Videos must include either sound (recorded narration) or subtitles.
- Videos must be free of commercial or product bias.
- Videos must be uploaded in HD, in order to assure the best quality possible. The minimum dimensions accepted are **1280x720 (720p); 1920x1080 (1080p)** and we suggest not compressing the file but leaving it in the original format. Please do not exceed the **maximum length of 60 FPS**.
- The submitter has to ensure that the link is fully accessible and remains this way for at least 3 months after the ESPGHAN 2026 Annual Meeting if accepted for presentation.
- Videos will be reviewed based on educational value and audio/visual quality. Clear narration or text overlay is recommended for better understanding.
- Ensure your video title and content are aligned with your abstract.
- Consider highlighting innovative techniques, rare cases, or complications, as these are of particular interest.

Patient Privacy and Identification:

- All personal data related to patients or examinations (e.g., date, time, place, patient name, birth date, unique ID, examiner name or ID) must be removed or covered from images and videos before submission.
- Findings/diagnoses and markings, such as arrows, are permitted.
- For any images or videos where individuals can be identified, written consent from the individual must be provided. If consent is not available, the material must be modified to ensure the individual is unidentifiable.
